During Lent, we will extend "Our Light is On" to include adoration on the third Wednesday of the month. Adoration includes prayers and intentions that correspond to a particular theme each month. Confession will also be available during this time.

Lenten Regulations – ABSTINENCE: Catholics over 14 years of age are bound to the obligations of abstinence. Abstinence is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent. On days of abstinence, meat may not be used at all.

FAST: Catholics over 18 and up to the beginning of their sixtieth year are bound to the obligation of fasting. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are the days of fasting. On these days, only one full meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed.

You may remember from years past, that on Wednesday evenings during Lent, parishes throughout the Archdiocese were open each Wednesday evening for confession. **This Lent we will again be providing the opportunity for the sacrament of reconciliation from 6:30 pm – 8:00 pm in the lower church beginning March 13.** All are urged to avail themselves of this wonderful opportunity to receive the Lord's grace and forgiveness in the sacrament.
