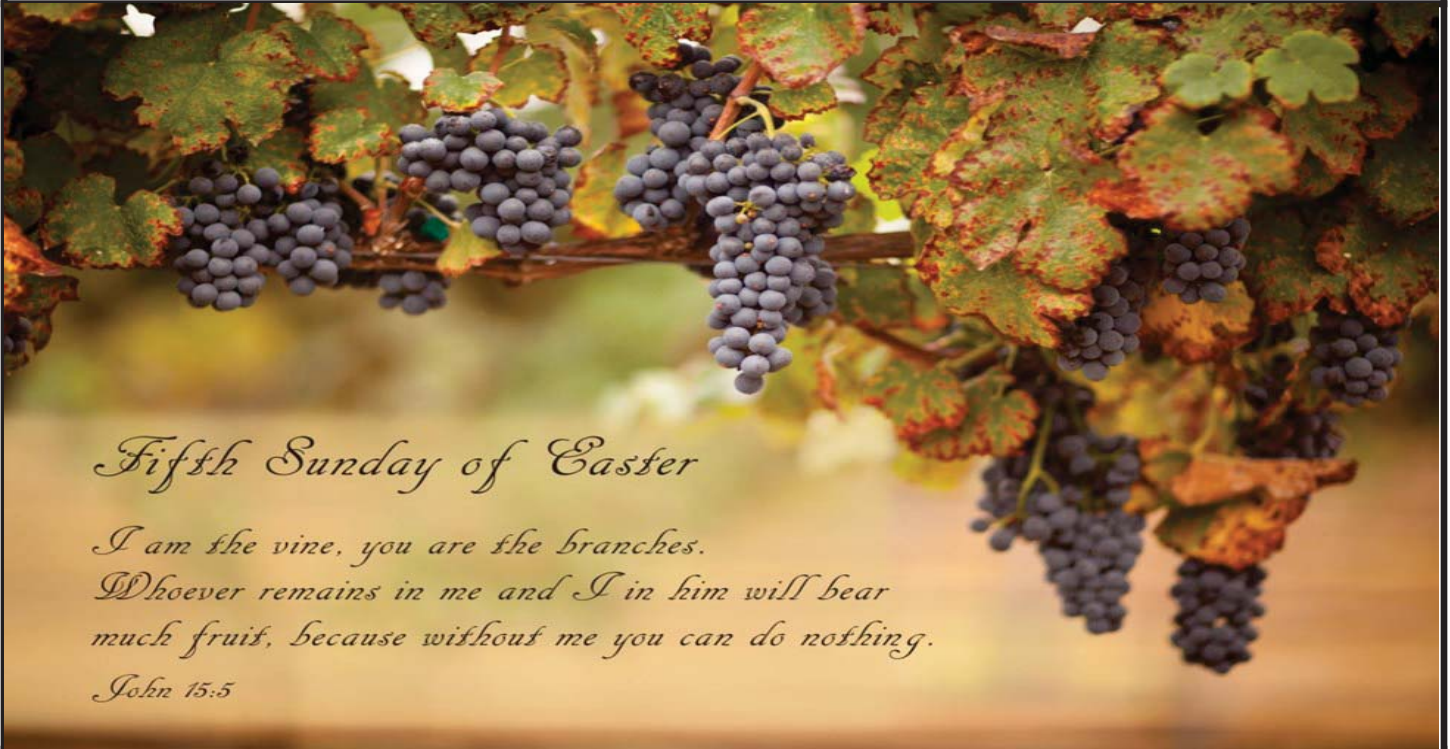

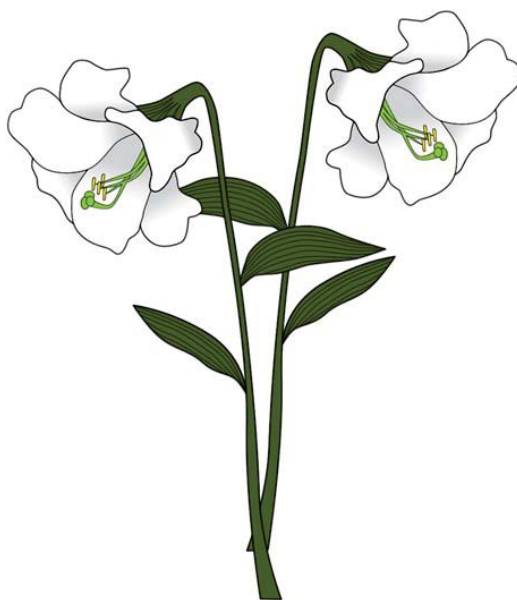

### Evangelio del Domingo

“...El viñador toma las tijeras de labranza y poda los sarmientos para que tengan más sol y luz, para que den racimos de uva sabrosa. Cristo mismo quiere podarnos, para que vivamos su propia vida. Quiere introducirnos en su Pasión, que la incorporemos en nuestra propia vida, que la encarnemos. De esa manera, recibimos un nuevo modo de ser. La vida de Cristo se vuelve también la nuestra: podemos pensar como Él, actuar como Él, ver el mundo y las cosas con los ojos de Jesús.

Y como consecuencia, podemos amar a los demás como él lo ha hecho: en su corazón, desde su corazón, con su corazón. Y llevar así al mundo frutos de bondad, de caridad y de paz. Este es el deseo de Jesucristo: arrancar nuestro corazón de piedra, y darnos un corazón de carne, lleno de vida, un corazón compasivo y misericordioso. Y nos pide que nos pongamos en sus manos llagadas, para que pueda quitar de nuestra vida lo que estorba, lo que nos separa de Dios.

Las pequeñas mortificaciones son, precisamente, un modo de decirle al Señor que nos quite soberbias, avaricias, enfados, iras, perezas, envidias, egoísmos, vanidades, rencores, impurezas.

Dejamos que el Espíritu Santo vaya podando todo lo que no es vivir en Cristo. Hace que nuestro corazón tenga la medida del corazón de Jesucristo. Si permitimos que la acción de Dios entre en nuestra vida, entonces permanecemos en su amor, damos fruto verdadero. Con nuestras pequeñas mortificaciones y actos de penitencia le estamos diciendo a Dios: “quiero vivir en ti, por ti, contigo”; “quiero hacer presente la fuerza de tu amor allí donde estoy”.

Por ello, no se trata de hacer grandes mortificaciones, sino de hacerlas con amor, pidiéndole al Señor que nos cambie el corazón y lo pongamos en los demás. Cristo nos da así una vida enamorada. Hacemos nuestra su vida y su muerte, de manera que Él puede vivir en nosotros por el amor. Y nos hace capaces de seguir sus pasos, corredimiendo a todas las almas, llevando su vida redentora a todos los lugares donde nos encontramos” - <https://opusdei.org/es-co/gospel/2024-04-28/>

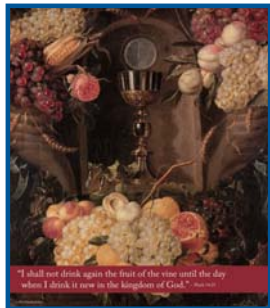

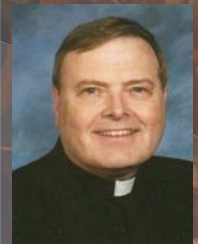
