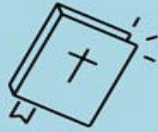

LENT

Lent begins Ash Wednesday, March 5th.

Masses for Ash Wednesday are at 7:00 and 9:00 am and 5:30 pm in English. The Spanish Mass will be at 7:00 pm.

GUIDELINES FOR FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Lenten fast and abstinence regulations are as follows:

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics fourteen (14) years of age and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting is to be observed by all Catholics who are eighteen (18) years of age but not yet fifty-nine (59) years of age on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed Lenten penitential practices.

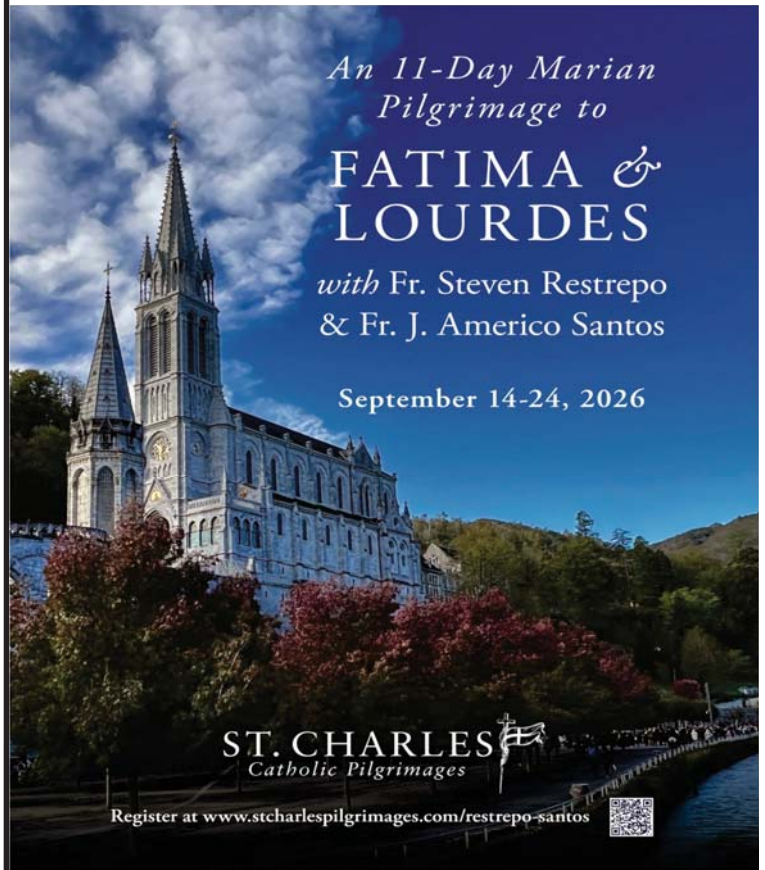

DÍA DE FIESTA-23 DE FEBRERO

Este discípulo de San Juan Apóstol fue nombrado Obispo de Esmirna (hoy Izmir, Turquía), presuntamente por Juan. Policarpo, quien representaba a las iglesias de Asia Menor, viajó a Roma alrededor del año 155 para discutir la fecha de la celebración de la Pascua. El resultado fue que las iglesias orientales y occidentales continuaron calculando la fecha como lo habían hecho anteriormente. Poco después de su retorno, Policarpo fue arrestado y le exigieron que renunciara a Dios. El rehusó y lo sentenciaron a morir en la hoguera. Cuando vieron que las llamas no le afectaban, lo mataron con una espada, esto es lo que relata un documento cristiano muy antiguo.
