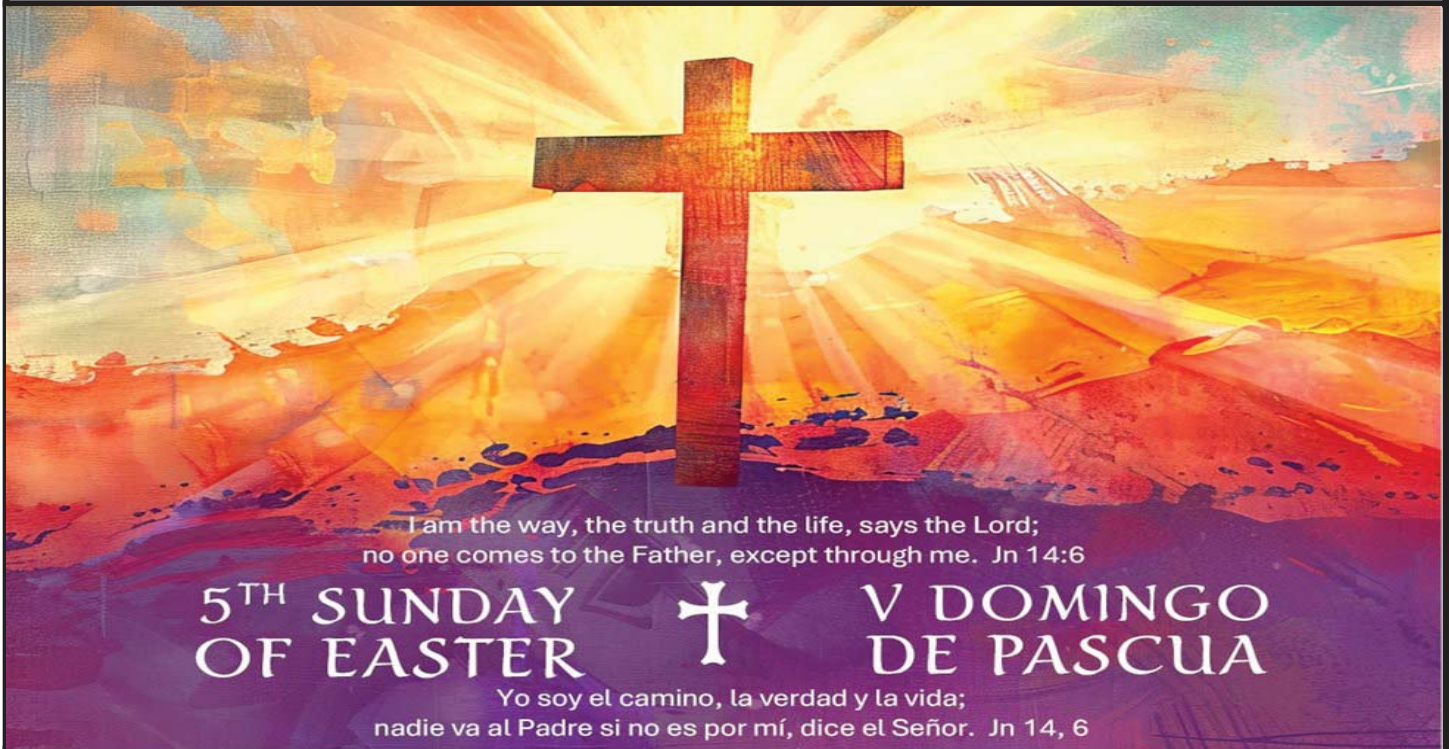

Couples planning marriage should make arrangements at least **SIX MONTHS** prior to the wedding date.

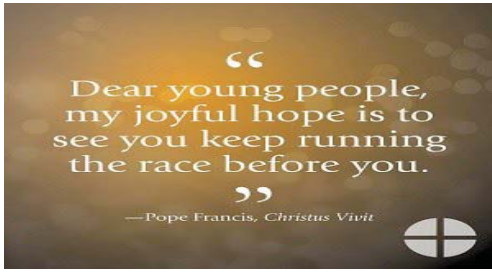

Did You Know...What is happening in the Archdiocese of Boston to protect children?

Adults and youth learn how to create a safe space, identify and avoid or respond to risk, and report concerns.

All parish and school staff and volunteers must take safe environment training (PGC) to learn how to identify and prevent abuse!

Staff in the Office of Pastoral Support and Child Protection can help parishes and schools to take all necessary steps to meet the child protection requirements. Just call and talk to any of us.

The Office of Pastoral Support and Child Protection provides ongoing support for healing for those who were sexually abused in the Boston church and for their families.

A volunteer independent Review Board assists the Archbishop in reviewing new allegations of sexual abuse by priests and makes recommendations for moving forward.

An audit is conducted by an independent firm to evaluate implementation of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. Findings are made available in an Annual Report.
